I researched a Japanese woman, Taguchi Ai who built a chocolate factory in Ghana. I'm going to tell you about her.

In 2018, when she was a university student, she visited a cacao farm in a village in Ghana. Cacao is the material to make chocolates. While she was staying in the village, she learned two things. First, the village people who produce cacao were poor, and many children in the village couldn't go to school. ①She was shocked about that. Second, many village people that she talked with didn't have experience eating chocolates. ②She was very surprised about that. The people who were producing cacao couldn't buy chocolate. Because cacao farmers have low incomes, it was too expensive for them.

At that time, she thought that she wanted many poor people to be able to eat chocolate. And then, she decided to build a chocolate factory in Ghana for the people who are working on the cacao farms. After she came back to Japan, she did various activities for her plan. Finally, she succeeded to build a chocolate factory in Ghana in 2022. She made her dream come true by taking action.

Now she goes and comes between Japan and Ghana to expand her business. When she is in Japan, ③she sells Ghana chocolates made of cacao which the village people produce. If I have a chance, ④ (them / to / want / that / she / buy / sells / I).
