Write an English summary of the passage in 60–70 words.

Large language models can produce summaries, translations, and draft documents quickly. These abilities may save time in workplaces, especially when employees need to handle routine writing tasks. However, systems can produce inaccurate statements or repeat biases found in their training data. They may also reveal sensitive information if users enter private material carelessly. Organizations that use these tools are therefore developing rules about checking outputs, protecting data, and deciding which tasks require human review. The aim is not simply to use AI more often, but to use it responsibly.

模範解答：Local newspapers face financial pressure as advertising moves online, and their closure can reduce information about community affairs. Nonprofit models, memberships, and public funding may help, but each raises concerns about independence. Sustainable solutions must provide reliable finances while protecting editorial freedom, since local reporting is valuable only when journalists can investigate issues without improper influence. This protects communities from improper pressure.

模範解答：I think cities should restrict short-term rentals in residential neighborhoods. First, housing should be protected. When many homes are converted into tourist accommodation, rents may rise and local residents can be forced to leave their communities. Second, the sense of community may weaken if neighbors change every few days and buildings become less stable. Tourism is important for local economies, so a complete ban may not be necessary. Cities could limit the number of rental days, require registration, and enforce rules against noise. These measures would allow some tourism income while ensuring that residential areas remain places where people can actually live. This balanced approach would protect housing while allowing tourism to contribute to the local economy in a responsible way.

模範解答：I think schools should allow limited use of AI tools for homework, provided that clear rules are established. First, AI can support learning by explaining difficult ideas or suggesting ways to organize a draft. Students may then spend more time improving their own work. Second, honesty must be protected. If students submit AI-generated answers without checking them, teachers cannot judge what students understand. Schools should require learners to state how they used a tool and to verify information themselves. Teachers can also design assignments that ask students to connect ideas to class discussion or personal evidence. In this way, AI can assist learning without replacing independent thought. Clear guidance would help students use new tools with confidence and academic integrity.
