Part 1 ライティング（英文要約・3題）

(1) 以下の英文「Reusable Packaging Services」を45～55語の英語で要約しなさい。

Reusable Packaging Services

Some online stores are testing reusable shipping boxes and bags. Customers receive an order in durable packaging, fold the empty container, and return it through a mailbox or collection point. The company cleans and checks the package before using it again.

Supporters say repeated use can reduce disposable cardboard and plastic. Strong packaging may also protect products better. However, producing durable containers requires more material, and collecting, cleaning, and transporting them uses energy. The environmental result depends on how many times each package is returned and reused.

Services therefore need convenient return points, clear instructions, and a way to track containers. Customers must participate consistently; otherwise, many packages disappear after one use and the system loses its main advantage.

(2) 以下の英文「Shared E-Scooters」を45～55語の英語で要約しなさい。

Shared E-Scooters

Shared electric scooters can help people travel short distances between stations, homes, and workplaces. They may reduce some car trips and are convenient when buses are infrequent. However, scooters left on sidewalks can block pedestrians, and inexperienced riders may cause accidents. Cities can require parking zones, speed limits, helmets, and data sharing from operators. The benefits depend on rules, safe streets, and responsible use.

(3) 以下の英文「Remote Medical Consultations」を45～55語の英語で要約しなさい。

Remote Medical Consultations

Video medical consultations can save travel time and help patients in areas with few clinics. They are useful for follow-up visits and simple questions when patients do not need a physical examination. Yet they depend on reliable Internet access, and doctors may miss signs that are easier to notice in person. Health services should protect private information and make it clear when an in-person visit is necessary.

Model Answers

英文要約 模範解答

(1) 英文要約

Reusable shipping packages are returned, cleaned, and used again, which may reduce disposable cardboard and plastic and protect goods. Yet durable materials, collection, cleaning, and transport also use resources. Environmental benefits require many reuse cycles, convenient return points, clear instructions, tracking systems, and consistent customer participation.

(2) 英文要約

Shared e-scooters offer convenient short trips and may replace some car travel. However, they can block sidewalks and cause accidents when riders are inexperienced. Cities should require designated parking, sensible speed limits, safety measures, and operator cooperation. Their value depends on responsible use and suitable street rules.

(3) 英文要約

Video consultations can improve access and save travel time, especially for follow-up care and simple questions. However, Internet problems and the lack of physical examinations can limit them. Health services must protect privacy and clearly direct patients promptly to in-person care when it is needed.

(4) 意見論述

I think car-free shopping areas can be a good idea when cities provide other transportation choices. First, streets without private cars are safer and more pleasant for people walking or cycling. They can also reduce noise and air pollution. Second, shops may benefit because visitors can spend time outdoors, attend events, and move easily between stores. However, deliveries and access for older people or those with disabilities must be protected. Cities should test the policy on weekends first and improve buses, parking, and delivery schedules before making it permanent.

(5) 意見論述

I agree that high school students should have opportunities to take part in volunteer work. First, helping at local events or supporting younger children can make students feel connected to their communities. They learn that small actions can solve real problems. Second, volunteer work develops useful skills such as communication, planning, and teamwork. These experiences may help students choose future careers. Schools should not force every student to do the same activity, however. They should offer several choices and allow students to balance volunteering with study, family responsibilities, and rest.

(6) 意見論述

I think public libraries should lend some useful items in addition to books. First, tools and musical instruments can be expensive, and many people need them only occasionally. Borrowing would allow residents to try an activity without buying everything at once. Second, shared items could bring neighbors together through workshops and local events. However, libraries would need clear rules about reservations, cleaning, and damage. They should begin with safe, durable items and provide instructions for use. With careful management, these services could make libraries more valuable community spaces.
